
MARKET SURVEY RESULTS

In 2024, Elevate conducted a survey within the ECE community to gain insights into their professional development experiences, needs, priorities, and barriers to accessing professional development. Below are key findings from the survey results.



DELIVERY METHODS

The majority **(42%-58%)** of directors, coaches, and ECE council staff all chose in-person as their top choice for methods of training delivery


49% of educators chose virtual as their top choice

40% of family home providers chose webinar as their top choice

Educators, directors, family home providers, and ECE council staff ranked **teaching practices & child development** as their top two priority topics when seeking professional development


Coaches ranked **coaching practices & teaching practices** as their top two priority topics

OPEN-ENDED RESPONSES

Participants were asked what kinds of professional development challenges they faced

"We cant pay for the time to attend PD and we can't afford to increase their wages for increasing their PD."

"Have been in the field 20 years. While there is always more to learn, many trainings lean towards newer teachers. I would love to have new activities, lessons to take back to my classroom."

"The cost is prohibitive for so many people. Teachers and administrators are not paid enough to spend their own money on PD and unfortunately schools don't always have it in their budget."

"I've been around so long that the trainings are repetitive for me. Need NEW training opportunities."
